

Why does Crushed Grapes have a vaccination requirement?

With health and safety as our top priority, we believe that this approach, including asking attendees to wear masks when not eating or drinking, is the best way to combat the pandemic. This policy is similar to (though not always exactly the same as) other events happening again throughout the city and what we hope will be a positive step in returning to a “new” normal.

What vaccine documentation will you accept?

The following documentation is acceptable:

- Vaccination card (which includes name of person vaccinated, type of vaccine provided and date last dose administered) from the healthcare provider(s) that performed the vaccination. You may present the original vaccination card OR:
- A photo of your vaccination card OR
- A photo of your vaccine card stored on a phone or electronic device OR
- A Digital Vaccination Passport app OR
- Documentation of vaccination from a healthcare provider electronic health record or state Immunization Information System record.
- Matching photo ID required at the door. Patrons under age 18 do not need ID if they are attending the event with an adult who can attest to the child’s identify. Children attending the event without an adult must have school or government issued ID.

Self-reported vaccination records that are not verified by a health care provider cannot be accepted.
